

**Death of Sunset Hills Surviving Member as it Applies to
Watercraft Slip/Lift Occupancy
April 2026**

This policy was adopted pursuant to the Board’s powers to impose membership and other fees under Article II, Sections A.5) and B.4) of the By-laws, as well as under Wis. Stat. § 181.0602.

Annual Boating Season April 15th – October 15th

#1 If a Sunset Hills Surviving Member passes prior to April 15th of the current calendar year, the slip/lift they were to occupy will be offered to the next member on the waiting list. The Financial Secretary will reimburse the family of the Surviving Member in the event payment was issued for the calendar year. The next member on the list will be responsible for the annual fee for the calendar year.

#2 During the boating season, should a Surviving Member pass, the Board will offer the children of the deceased the option to retain the use of the slip/lift for the remainder of the boating season. Should the children choose to retain the slip/lift, they will notify the Board immediately if there are any changes to the current registration and insurance policy on file with the Sunset Hills Association. Upon the end of the boating season for the calendar year (October 15), the next member on the waiting list will be offered the slip/lift.

#3 During the boating season, should a Surviving Member pass and the surviving children choose not to occupy the slip/lift for the remainder of the season, the following procedure will be followed: The family will have 30 days to remove their watercraft and boat lift (if applicable). The next member on the waiting list will be offered that slip/lift. The Financial Secretary will reimburse the family based on the six-month Annual Boating Season timeline (April 15th - October 15th) and payment is based on the day the slip/lift is vacated. The new member will be responsible for the remaining monthly fee based on the same procedure.

This policy is only applicable in the event of the death of a Surviving Member. All By-Laws regarding boats and watercraft will be followed.
